

See and do

The municipality of Malung-Sälen can offer world-class events.

Here the starting pistol sounds for the world's oldest, biggest and longest ski race – Vasaloppet. In summer, the ever-growing Cykel-Vasa is run, in which both exercise cyclists and the elite take part. And the Swedish Dance Band Week in Malung attracts more and more visitors.

The nearly 200 other associations that are active in the municipality offer a rich choice of activities for all inclinations and tastes. There are very successful sports clubs with world class competitors in sports such as, for example, alpine skiing, shooting and orienteering.

There are also countless wonderful open air baths in the municipality, public baths in Malung, the Experium adventure baths in Sälen, many sports halls and gymnasia and the sports field in Malung with bandy pitches, illuminated ski track, bowling and curling sports halls.

The libraries in Malung and Sälen, in addition to well-stocked bookshelves, can also offer interesting and stimulating lectures, exhibitions and programmes for the very young.

The municipal culture school is aimed at young people who wish to learn to dance, sing, play instruments or take part in drama and theatre. The teachers at the school teach almost 300 pupils every week.

The municipality of Malung-Sälen safeguards the local cultural heritage, and there are five community centres to visit. The millstone bridge in Östra Utsjö is Dalarna's first cultural reserve. The bridge is 1.7 kilometres long, and apart from a bracing walk, also provides an opportunity for a marvellous natural and cultural experience.

The leather industry was formerly the dominant feature of the municipality. In Öje, about 15 km east of the centre of Malung, there is a well-preserved leather workshop from the mid-1900s that can be visited. Jannesgården in Malung puts on a leather exhibition, with gives an historical background to today's activities in the leather sector.

In the municipality of Malung-Sälen we live close to what really means something. Here there is fresh air, mountains, skiing, snowmobiling, fishing lakes and wilderness. Those of us who live in Malung-Sälen have made an active choice to do so, because we think that quality of life is important.
